AIRPORT

Denver International Airport is the home base for Frontier Airlines, a major hub for United Airlines, and a growing base for Southwest Airlines. Check out their website www.flydenver.com for a full listing of airlines that service the airport.

When booking your flights, please plan to arrive in Denver by 4:00pm on November 9th, and to leave Denver after 3:00pm on November 11th.

LOCAL INFORMATION

If you're looking to extend your stay in Denver, check out their website www.denver.org for some great ideas.

Denver weather in the fall is sunny and pleasant, with warm days and cool evenings. Daytime temperatures can vary from warm to crisp, so several layers of medium weight clothes (shirts, sweaters, and jackets) will allow adjustment for maximum comfort.

Don't forget sun protection (sunglasses, sunscreen, lip balm) as Denver's higher elevation provides less protection from the sun's rays.
